The first clothing optional hotel in town and still Zipolite's most famous attracts a variety of Mexican and foreign nudists year round. The hotel has about 30 spacious cabaña style rooms and its own clothing optional restaurant and swimming pool. Because of its location right on the beach this is the perfect place for them who like their vacation 24/7 clothes free.

Casablanca Guest House - RECOMMENDED

For those of you who like western comfort, Casablanca is certainly the place to go. Extremely soft beds, air conditioning, fully supplied kitchens and a large balcony overlooking the Pacific ocean. Casablanca has one of the fastest internet connections in town, a salt water infinity pool and a common area with games. This clothing optional guest house is located in a quiet area at a 15 minute walk from the main beach. Scooters are available for rent.
